Battery Label Change in Compliance with EU Battery Regulation

The battery label has been changed as follows to comply with the EU Battery Regulation.

1. Target Model

* Products derived from the above models with built-in batteries are also subject to the change.




2. Details of the Change

To comply with the EU Battery Regulation, the following indications have been added to the battery.

- CE mark
- The address of the manufacturer
- The URL of the manufacturer

For the label of some Q6BAT products, stickers have been affixed in response to the change.

4. For Customers Exporting to EU Member States



It is necessary to comply with the EU Battery Regulation when launching products onto the market of EU Member States from August 18, 2024.

When exporting batteries or products containing batteries to EU member states, customers (importers in the EU) may be required to comply with the EU Battery Regulation, such as manufacturer registration, importer obligations, etc.

When exporting products not complying with the EU Battery Regulation to EU member states, please contact your local sales office. Replacement with batteries bearing the CE mark or documentation such as Declaration of Conformity will be required.
